Game Scheduling:

Each team must play one HOME and one AWAY game against each of the opposing teams in their division/conference during the regular season. Any and all scheduling questions and changes though out the season should be emailed to: **Sean Edwards, AVMHL Scheduler at:** avmhlpresidentsean@gmail.com

If a HOME game is RESCHEDULED, please send the updated game information (your team name and division, new date/time, who you play and where) to the League Scheduler ASAP via email.

*Some divisions/conferences may play more than one home and one away game. This will be evaluated by the AVMHL Executive based on the number of teams per division/conference and those impacted will be advised at the scheduling meeting.

Scores/Game Results:

All HOME teams must submit their game results **by the following Thursday at 11:59 PM** to the League Statistician. If the results have not been submitted by the deadline imposed above, the game will be ruled a forfeit in favor of the visiting team. Away teams do not submit the score. Travel Permit:

The AVMHL travel permit for the 2023-2024 season will also be listed on the AVMHL website.

AVMHL Permit #: 2023-001

This permit only applies to the AVMHL Regular Season, Playoffs and Day of Champions games. Teams MUST obtain their own travel permits to play exhibition games, tournaments, etc.

League Fees/Rosters:

League Fees are \$25.00 per player for the 2023-2024 season.

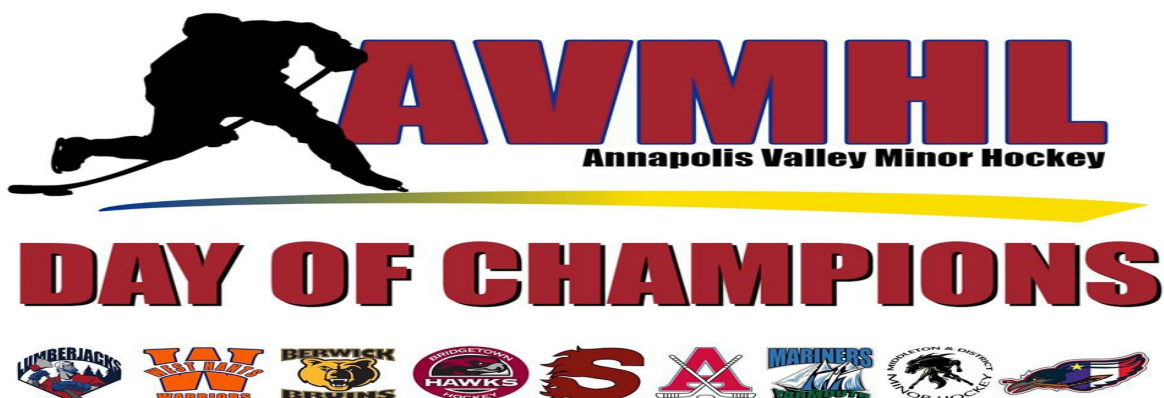
Official Hockey Canada rosters are to be forwarded to the League Treasurer, Andrea Pothier, by **November 30, 2023** from each Association Registrar. Rosters are to be sent via email to: **Andrea Pothier, AVMHL Treasurer at: apothier@avmhl.com**

Once rosters are received, invoices will be prepared and sent to each of the Association Treasurers no later than December 15, 2023. League Fees are due to AVMHL on or before **January 15, 2024**. ***Payment of league fees can not be accepted via e-transfer and must be forwarded via cheque as per the instructions provided on the AVMHL invoice. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.***

Cancellation of Games Due to Weather:

It is the responsibility of teams to re-schedule and make up any league scheduled games that are canceled due to weather or for other extenuating circumstances. If the game is not played, no points will be awarded to either team.
